

Cognition Maths (Number and Shape, Space and Measure)

- Maths songs and rhymes e.g. 10 little monkeys swinging from the tree
- Maths story: 'We all went on safari'
- Recognising and writing numbers up to 10/20
- Simple addition and subtraction
- Animal patterns



Cognition Literacy (Reading and Writing)

Story: Giraffe on a bicycle



- Sequencing and story recall – what next?
- Joining in with actions, repeated phrases
- **Reading:** choosing and sharing books, comprehension, See and Learn, matching picture to object, answering questions about the stories
- **Jolly Phonics**
- **Writing:** mark making, pencil control, trace and copy lines and curves, letter formation.


Communication and Language



- Makaton signs related to learning theme
- Switches to make choices in all aspects of learning
- Following instructions e.g. taking register to the office
- Visuals – photos and symbols of key concepts
- Making choices at snack time using eye pointing, words signs, gestures, communication boards and PECS
- Role play and using imaginative speech
- 1:1 Personalised Learning Goals (PLG's)
- Attention Autism sessions tailored to individual needs

Understanding the World/Topic/ICT/RE

- Animal habitats – in the trees/on the ground
- Using technology such as communication aids, switches, cause and effect toys, simple computer games.

Week 1-6: In the Jungle

Social, Emotional and Mental Health



- Playing with toys appropriately
- Looking after own belongings, putting coat on peg etc.
- Understanding feelings and emotions, and how to self regulate feelings.
- Daily mindfulness activities during together time e.g. sensory bottles and yoga

Expressive Arts and Design

- Musical Interaction
- Jungle music session
- Joining in with songs and rhymes about different animals
- Exploring materials through a range of crafts e.g. animal masks, clay animals, animal patterns
- Role play: Jungle explorers



Sensory and Physical Development (Gross Motor)

- Rebound therapy
- PE sessions- including ball games eg. rounders, throwing and catching skills.



Sensory and Physical Development (Fine Motor)

- Funky fingers e.g. cutting, sticking, puzzles, playdough
- TACPAC
- Writing- forming lines, squares, circles and letters
- **Independence** – buttering own toast, pouring drinks, getting ready for PE/swimming.
