

On the advice of PHE Secondary Site Bubble 1 has been closed and we have advised all staff and pupils to self-isolate up to and including Thursday 5th November. This is because a member of staff developed symptoms on Saturday 24th October and has subsequently tested positive.

Please follow the stay at home advice. If you develop possible symptoms during this period you will need to be tested and other members of your household should also begin to self-isolate.

The stay at home advice for people with learning disabilities says:

‘Not all these measures will be possible if you, or those you live with, have conditions such as learning disabilities, autism or serious mental illnesses. Follow this guidance to the best of your ability, whilst keeping yourself and those close to you safe and well, ideally in line with any existing care plans.’

This means you may choose to take your child out but should make sure you do not have contact with people beyond your household. Do not visit shops, cafes or other busy or enclosed areas, as this could put others at risk. However limited outdoor activity away from other people would be acceptable.
